

Uniform policy - Reception to Year 6

Together with our school logo and the values of welcoming, respecting and constructing, the wearing of the uniform symbolizes our unity and identity as a Catholic school community. At Cardijn College Galilee students are expected to wear the school uniform at all times. Whilst wearing the uniform, such as on excursions, before or after school etc, students are representing Cardijn College Galilee and are expected to uphold the image and identity of our community. The uniform must be worn with pride and reflect our image and identity at all times.

Parental support and cooperation is essential in supporting the school to achieve high standards. As part of the enrolment parents sign a declaration 'I/we accept the standards school sets regarding grooming, uniform and personal presentation.'

Students are expected to wear the standard uniform each day of the week unless notified by school staff. There will be two days per week when home groups will have a set physical education lesson requiring the full school sports uniform to be worn.

During terms 1 and 4 summer items shall be worn and in terms 2 and 3 winter items are to be worn. In the case of cooler or warmer weather conditions at change over of terms:

- Summer items may be worn in the first week of term 2 or last week of term 3.
- Winter items may be worn in the last week of term 1 or the first week of term 4.

Hat - Sun smart policy

Students must have a school sun safe bucket or slouch hat to be worn whenever the UV levels are 3 or higher as per the Sunsmart Primary Schools Guidelines. Students without hats will be required to go to the stages or under the verandah during outside learning times.

Standard of uniform

Uniforms should be kept clean, well presented and appropriately worn at all times. Over time uniform items become tattered and must be replaced.

Parents/carers are expected to notify their child's homeroom teacher of the appropriate reason why their child is not wearing the standard uniform.

Should the School Uniform Policy continue to be infringed or disregarded after three times, with notes home being provided, your child will be excluded from outside learning and excursions, and school functions where they will be representing the school, as the uniform expectation is not being honoured. Learning will continue. If there is ongoing recurrence to adhere to the uniform parents/caregivers will be contacted by school leadership.

We are aware that 'trends' come and go and different items come from time to time. The school has the right to make amendments as necessary to ensure the standard and image of the school is upheld. No other items can be introduced to the uniform without approval of the Principal.

Our uniform has been designed to be inclusive. If you have any queries please do not hesitate to contact your child's homeroom teacher or the front office.

Labelling and lost property

Parents/carers are strongly encouraged to label **all** uniform items to ensure they are safely returned to children. The lost property basket is located at the admin building should you be missing a uniform item.

Shirt	White short/long sleeve banded shirt

Pants	Navy Gabardine "Blockers" Drawstring or Navy Serge "Classic" ½ Elastic waist
Windcheater	Teal V-neck windcheater with logo
Socks	White ankle style sock (crew sock) covering the ankle with dress/culotte set - no brands or colours to be seen or
Socks	Navy Ankle Style with shorts and pants
School shoes	Black school shoes (including lady jane style, no ballet flats or decorations). This can include lace up, Velcro or buckle. Black or navy leather style sandals without socks No canvas or casual shoes to be worn.

Pinafore	Winter Galilee Tartan – Bib style Years R-2, length to the knee
Skirt	Winter Galilee Tartan - Years 3-7, length to the knee
Shirt	White long/short sleeve banded shirt
Shorts	Navy "Blockers" Elastic Waist
Pants	Navy Gabardine "Blockers" Drawstring or Navy Serge "Classic" ½ Elastic waist
Windcheater	Teal V-neck windcheater with logo
Tights/Socks	Navy tights "Becky" or white fold over sock covering the ankle with dress/culotte set- no brands labels or colours to be seen. or
Socks	Navy Ankle Style with shorts and pants
Shoes	Black school shoes. This can include lace up, Velcro or buckle No canvas or casual shoes to be worn.

SPORTS UNIFORM

Polo Shirt	Short Sleeve teal cool-mesh with logo
Shorts	Navy Knit Fabric - length just above the knee (No culottes/skorts)
Track pants	BBT Navy fleece Straight leg Or Navy B & L Fleece – Double Knee (No strips or colours)
Windcheater	Teal V-neck windcheater with logo
Socks	White ankle length socks – no logos, brands or colours are to be seen
Shoes	Sports sneakers, predominately white in colour. Logos may be seen. No specialist 'sports' shoes or casual foot wear ie no skate, ankle boots or canvas shoes.
Hat	Navy blue with logo – bucket, slouch

OTHER ITEMS

Hat	Navy blue with logo – bucket or slouch style
Senior Jumper /T-shirt	Designed, ordered and worn by senior students with approval from the principal. The design, style and image must reflect the school image and identity (no hoods), contain the logo and only first names of students.
Beanies, Scarves & gloves	Plain Navy blue – no logos, patterns or symbols. Optional and only worn outside during terms 2 &3
Jackets	Plain Navy Blue - no logos, patterns or symbols and can be worn outside during terms 2 &3
Sports Briefs	Navy boy leg only – not to be seen only worn under a dress i.e. no leggings
Stockings	Navy school tights
Art smocks	Waterproof (R-7)
School Bags	All students must have the required navy blue school bag with logo (Available from Front Office).
Hair Accessories	Hair accessories are to reflect the school uniform. Clips & clasps – brown, black, silver or white School colours – Galilee summer check or tartan, teal, navy <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Scrunchies○ Thin Headband○ Small Ribbons and Small Bows on elastic (no fashion bows ie JOJO Bows)○ Wide Headband○ Round button

Accessories and jewellery

- Earrings – studs or sleepers, silver or gold, only one earring per ear lobe only. No other body piercing i.e. nose, ear cuff etc.
- Necklaces are discouraged for safety reasons, only religious i.e. cross are allowed. No ‘fashion jewellery i.e. crosses’
- Watches can be worn – black, silver, gold, leather type band, no bright colours or “smart” watches (Like mobile phones, smart watches will need to be given to teachers at the beginning of the day for safe keeping and be collected at the end of the day).
- No bracelets
- Medic alert bracelets or necklaces are allowed
- No nail polish, fake nails or make up

Hair

As determined by Cardijn College Galilee, hair is to be kept neat and natural in line with our school image and identity. This includes, but is not limited to:

- No coloured hair – either permanent or with gels or sprays
- Hair needs to be at least No. 3 in length
- No alternative/unusual cut/hairstyles i.e. no shaved, patterned cuts, colour patterns, mohawks. Hair may be worn/covered in keeping with Religious traditions i.e. Sikh
- Hair longer than shoulder length must to be tied back (boys and girls)
- If hair is not within these specifications then parents will be asked to rectify and the student will have to wear hair up and/or a hat to cover whilst in public, ie outside learning/excursions/events ec

School shoes

Black school shoes that have 'appearance' like a sneaker but are a school shoe are accepted. Often these shoes are leather and designed for active wear at school. (i.e. Clarks). What is not accepted is black sneakers or canvas shoes.

Black shoes are to be plain (i.e. no decorations/flowers). We have provided some examples to help.
